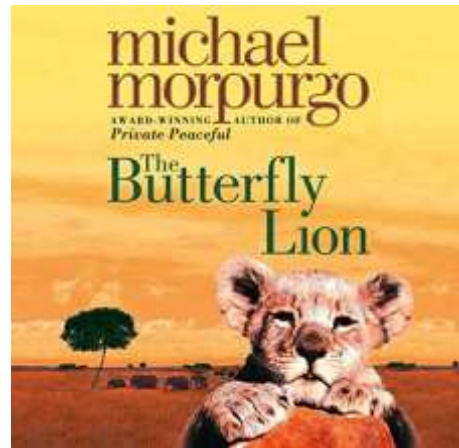
Summer Newsletter
