
School Vision

What is the Early Years Foundation Stage (E.Y.F.S)?



- The E.Y.F.S. is the stage of education for children from birth to the end of the Reception year.
- It is based on the recognition that children learn best through play and active learning.

It is developed around 4 themes that underpin the EYFS

1. A unique Child- Observe what a child is learning
2. Positive Relationships- What adults can do
3. Enabling Environments- What adults could provide
4. Learning and Developing- Children's achievements through the above



In the Early Years at Bader we believe in providing children with a safe and stimulating environment where they can be themselves. We pride ourselves on listening to children and those who care for them and using this information to personalise each child's learning. What can you do to help your child's learning when they begin school?

Sharing books, talking about the pictures

Reading Book, make comments in their reading diary

Read/share books at least 3 times a week

Ongoing-encourage mark making; drawing pictures, shopping lists etc.

Encourage children to talk.

Counting at any time-climbing the stairs, shopping etc

Play simple board games

Sing number rhymes and songs together

Support any homework that comes home, sounds and number work
