Please continue to use class dojo regularly to keep up with any messages from school. You can also contact your child's class teacher there.

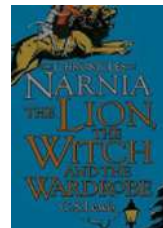
We are also continuing to use 'Seesaw'.
