WW1

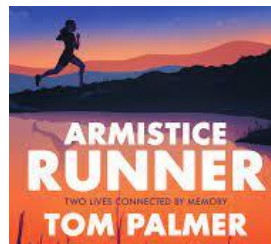
This term we will be learning about WW1. This is commencing with our exciting hook day where the children will complete a variety of activities to 'enrol as a soldier'.
