### Reminders:

### Times tables Test:

Year 4 will be completing a statutory times tables test this term, in which they will be asked 25 times tables questions up to 12 x 12. It is important for your child to practice their times tables regularly.

Children should have white shirts/polo shirts, green jumper or cardigan and grey/black trousers, skirt or pinafores. If wearing leggings, they must be covered by a skirt or pinafore. Footwear must be black shoes or plain black trainers.

- Spelling Shed




Children will continue to receive spellings and times tables on a Monday on Seesaw. Our spelling test takes place on a Monday and the Times Tables test takes place on a Friday.

### Our Learning:

This term, our History topic will be 'Anglo-Saxons and Vikings'. We will be exploring why they chose to invade England and discover the journeys they took to get here.

Our class text will be Matilda. We will continue to develop our reading skills using VIPERS during each Reading lesson.



Our Science topic is 'States of Matter'. We will be looking into the properties of solids, liquids and gases and how different substances and materials can change states.
