KS2 SATs 2023

SATs will start the **w/c 8th May**. Children can come into school from 8:30am through the main office. Please ensure that children have a good night's sleep and arrive at school promptly. The schedule for the week is as follows:

Tuesday 9th May – Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar

Wednesday 10th May - Reading

Thursday 11th May — Mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)

Friday 12th May - Mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)

SATs boosters, both morning and after school **are** taking place in the lead up to SATs.

There will be no SATs Boosters after school or morning boosters during SATs week. The last morning and after school booster sessions will take place on **Thursday 4th May.**

School Uniform

Children should have white shirts/polo shirts, green jumper/cardigan, grey/black trousers, skirt or pinafores. If wearing leggings, they must be covered by a skirt or pinafore. Footwear must be black shoes or plain black trainers. Children are not allowed to wear jewellery unless it is stud earrings.

Please ensure all clothing is labelled with children's names.

When children receive their Y6 leavers' hoodies, they will be allowed to wear them as part of their uniform. **The hoodies have arrived** and will be handed out on **Monday 15th May**.
