Our Learning:

This term, our Geography topic is 'Down Under.' We will be learning about Australia and New Zealand looking in particular at the landscapes and climate of these places. We will be reading 'Grandad's Island, by Benji Davies and, 'Rabbit and Bear' by Julian Gough'. In Science, we will be learning about Animals including Humans and continuing with our work on Plants. In Religion and World Views we will be learning about Christianity and what Jesus left behind. In Computing, we will be learning about Data handling and Video Creation.

Home Learning: Children will receive spellings on a Monday. These can be learned over the week and will be tested on the Friday of the same week.

This term, we will also join in with the school times tables championships. We will begin to learn about multiplication and division and the children will start to bring home times tables to practise ready for a test which we will every Thursday. We have started with doubles to get the children used to completing a test weekly. We are also continuing with our whole school reading initiative 'Read for the Stars'. Please can you continue to read with your child regularly at home. The expectation for KS1 is that the children read at home **4 times a** week.
