Communication

We will be continuing to use ClassDojo as our primary method of communication. Please use the messaging services on ClassDojo if you need to speak to Mrs Parr. We will use Tapestry to record observations of children's learning and progress. Please speak to a member of staff if you have any issues with using either of these apps.



Outdoor Learning

The outdoor classroom is just as important as the inside classroom. We use the outdoor classroom daily to support children's development. Please ensure that children come to school dressed appropriately for the weather and bring wellington boots.

Reading Books

Reading packets will go home on a weekly basis. They will contain a reading for pleasure book and a reading book for your child to read to you. It is important that you encourage your child to read their book everyday. Please can all reading packets be brought back to school on a Thursday.

Nursery Uniform

Please make sure that your child is dressed appropriately for Nursery. They will be moving around and getting messy. Please make sure that all clothes are labelled including shoes. We recommended children wear the following to. Nursery:
Leggings or trousers
White or green T-shirt
Green jumper or cardigan

Reminders

Children need to bring a bag everyday with spare clothes in. Children should not be bringing toys into school.
