
Year 2 Summer Newsletter

Our Learning:

This term, our History topic is 'Captain Cook'. We will be learning his life and his adventures. We have a couple of exciting trips planned around this topic, with the first being to Whitby on Wednesday 24th April. We will be reading 'The Pirates Next Door', by Jonny Duddle. In Science, we will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats. In Religion and World Views we will be learning about Islam focussing on the Qur'an and the mosque. In Computing, we will be learning how to create an avatar and also how to program a 'knock knock' joke.

Home Learning: Children will receive spellings on a Monday. These need to be learned over the week and then there will be a test on the Friday of the same week.

This term, we will continue to learn times table facts and these will be sent home weekly to practise ready for a test, which will be every Thursday. We are also continuing with our whole school reading initiative 'Read for the Stars'. Some children are already on the 3rd rocket and are steaming ahead to complete it! Please can you continue to read with your child regularly at home. The expectation for KS1 is that the children read at home **4 times a week.**
