Communication

We will use Tapestry to record observations of children's learning and progress. Please speak to a member of staff if you have any issues with using either of these apps.

Outdoor Learning

The outdoor classroom is just as important as the inside classroom. We use the outdoor classroom daily to support children's development. Please ensure that children come to school dressed appropriately for the weather and bring wellington boots.

Reception Uniform
